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# **COMBINED PRIMARY/INFANTS ATHLETICS CARNIVAL**

Dear Parents and Carers,

Our Primary and Infants athletics carnival is held on the same day at the same venue.

WHAT:	K-6 Athletics Carnival
WHEN:	Week 10 - Monday 2 <sup>nd</sup> July, 2018
WHERE:	Parker Street Reserve, King Street, Penrith (entrance via Coreen Ave)
TIME:	9.30am to approximately 1.30pm
WHAT TO WEAR:	School sports uniform including school hat and sunscreen.
	Children may wear a coloured t-shirt that reflects their team house.
WHAT TO BRING:	Students will need to bring crunch and sip, recess, lunch and drinks in their school bag or a plastic bag with their name on it.
	Please note the canteen will be available on the day <b>for parents only</b> . Alternatively, parents are invited to bring along their own picnic lunch and refreshments. A picnic blanket and/or chairs is also recommended.
MEDICATION:	Any primary students who require asthma medication will need to carry it with them. Infants student's medication with be kept with a nominated teacher.
TRAVEL:	<b>ALL</b> students need to attend school in the morning so that the roll can be marked and then they will travel to the oval by bus.
COST:	The cost of this event is included in the general activity payment as is permission to attend.

#### <u>Infants Carnival</u>

Infants students will participate in running races, ball games and other novelty events.

#### <u> Primary Carnival</u>

<u>All</u> primary students will participate in the 100 metre, 200 metre races, long jump, shot put, discus, high jump and the novelty events. The children will be asked to indicate to their classroom teacher if they wish to participate in the 800 metre race.

Any student who has a Little A's record for high jump or discus and would like to represent the school at the Zone Carnival, please hand results to Miss Reynolds for consideration.

#### <u>Running of the Day</u>

This year we will be working alongside Dance Fever Multi-Sport, who will be assisting with the running of our carnival. During Term Two, the students have had the opportunity to learn and practise their athletic skills with coaches from Dance Fever Multi-Sport.

As in previous years, students will need to remain with their class/age groups during the day. Parents are asked to spectate from the grandstand/seating area. Parents are welcome to join the Infants children on the oval for novelty events.

Parents may take their child home from the oval at the *conclusion of the carnival at 1.30pm*. Students will need to be marked off with their class teacher before leaving the oval.
